IRC Section 501(c)(3) may be required to file an annual information return - Form 990, Form 990-EZ, Form 990-N (see below) or Form 990-PF along with certain schedules that may be required for your organization.

7 Section 501(c)(3) requires that your organizing document must provide that upon dissolution, your remaining assets be used exclusively for section 501(c)(3) exempt purposes. Depending on your entity type and the state in which you are formed, this requirement may be satisfied by operation of state law.

A 501(c)(3) donation receipt is required to be completed by charitable organizations when receiving gifts in a value of \$250 or more. It's utilized by an individual that has donated cash or payment, personal property, or a vehicle and seeking to claim the donation as a tax deduction.

The Internal Revenue Service grants tax exemption status to non-profit organizations operating in the United States. How to Obtain 501(c)(3) Tax-Exempt Status for Your ...
501(c)(3), (4), (8), (10) or (19) organizations are exempt from Texas franchise tax and sales tax. A federal tax exemption only applies to the specific organization to which it is granted. Note that when an organization changes its structure, it effectively creates a new organization and must reapply for both federal and state tax exemption.

(a) Organizational and operational tests. (1) In order to be exempt as an organization described in section 501(c)(3), an organization must be both organized and operated exclusively for one or more of the purposes specified in such section. All 501(c)(3)s are nonprofits, but not all nonprofits are 501(c)(3)s. A nonprofit is incorporated under State law, while recognition of 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status is done at the federal level by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Failure to file Form 990 for three consecutive years automatically revokes the 501(c)(3) status of the organization. If this happens, you need to re-apply for tax-exempt status. 501(c)(3) Tax-Compliant Donation Receipt Requirements. The receipt can take a variety of written forms - letters, formal receipts, postcards, computer-generated forms, etc... It's important to remember that without a written acknowledgment, the donor cannot claim the tax deduction.
