### Critical Thinking and Decision Making in Nursing ...

Facione (1990) defines Critical Thinking as a purposeful self-regulatory judgment. Halpern (1989) defines it as a purposeful goal directed thinking. Critical Thinking is an essential component of Nursing since a nurse is always, by profession, confronted with complex situations, which demand accurate judgments, clinical decision-making and a continuous learning process.

Simply put, critical thinking in nursing is a purposeful, logical process which results in powerful patient outcomes. "Critical thinking involves interpretation and analysis of the problem, reasoning to find a solution, applying, and finally evaluation of the outcomes," according to a 2010 study published in the Journal of Nursing Education. This definition essentially covers the nursing process and reiterates that critical thinking builds upon a solid foundation of sound clinical knowledge.

### Critical Thinking: A Vital Trait for Nurses - Minority Nurse

Critical thinking in nursing is particularly essential for correctly assessing, interpreting and analyzing information with discretion and without value judgments, with the goal of determining appropriate diagnostic and decision-making needs. These skills are desirable in all areas of nursing, especially direct patient care.

### Effectiveness of teaching strategies to improve critical ...

Facione (2011) states that critical thinking is a part of what we mean by good thinking and involves cognitive skills such as interpretation, analysis, evaluation, inference, explanation, and self-regulation. A lack of critical thinking may manifest as a failure to anticipate the consequences of one's actions (Facione, 2007). In Cody's article (2002), he describes how critical thinking has become a buzzword in nursing and educational literature, void of any real substance.

Critical thinking in nursing involves applying knowledge and experience to identify patient problems and directing clinical judgments by selecting from alternatives, weighing evidence, using intuition, and by pattern recognition.
