Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program projects are state-funded projects that cannot obtain primary funding under other state programs. Projects that can normally obtain funding from PENNDOT, PENNVEST, the Department of Community and Economic Development, or other state agencies are generally restricted from participating in the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program.

Program Guidelines - Office of the Budget

All federal funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the previous calendar year. The agency responsible for carrying out the project or phase. Sufficient project descriptions (such as type of work, termini, length, and other similar factors) to identify the project or phase of the project.

If this contract is being funded with FTA grant funds, then it must incorporate the requirement at 49 CFR §26.29 that requires prime contractors to pay their subcontractors (all of them, not just DBEs) promptly and return the subcontractors' retainage within a specific number of days after the sub's work is completed.
