"Ethan Brand--A Chapter from an Abortive Romance" (originally, "The Unpardonable Sin") is a short story written by Nathaniel Hawthorne in 1850 and first published by Ticknor, Reed, and Fields in 1852 in The Snow-Image, and Other Twice-Told Tales, the author's final collection of short stories. Hawthorne originally planned a lengthy work about Brand, but completed only this piece.

In terms of themes, Hawthorne and his main characters are typically preoccupied with the effort of resolving the base desires and fallibilities of human beings with the divine commandments to embody particular spiritual and religious values and there is a clear sense of the meaning of unpardonable sin.
