A spider web, spiderweb, spider's web, or cobweb (from the archaic word *coppe*, meaning "spider") is a structure created by a spider out of proteinaceous spider silk extruded from its spinnerets, generally meant to catch its prey.. Spider webs have existed for at least 100 million years, as witnessed in a rare find of Early Cretaceous amber from Sussex, southern England.

Although webs are the most well-known use for spider silk, not all spiders make webs to catch their prey. In fact, less than half of the 37 spider families in Britain do. Other spiders, such as crab spiders in the family Thomisidae, are 'sit and wait' predators - for example *Misumena vatia* lurks on flower heads, waiting to ambushing visiting insects.

Though all spiders make silk, only some spiders use their silk to construct webs for capturing prey. Some spiders actively hunt for their food, including two of the more recognizable families: wolf spiders (Lycosidae) and jumping spiders (Salticidae). The spider species that use webs to hunt prey create webs of an assortment of shapes and sizes (Figure 3).
